Bismarck Legacy Girls Basketball Booster Tournament Rules

Regular High School Rules will be used with the exceptions and changes listed below.

- 1. Players must compete in own age level with exception of younger grades may play up. Example, 3rd graders can play at 4th grade level and up.
- 2. Players may only play on ONE team. Penalty is disqualification of both teams involved.
- 3. All teams must wear uniform shirts with a visible number on the back and front if possible.
- 4. Three-point shot will be used in all divisions if the floor is marked.
- 5. 7th and 8th division can play any defense and full court press anytime. Would urge good sportsmanship if the score is wide margin.
- 6. 3rd-6th division is man to man defense only. No zone. Full court press last 2 minutes of game if score is 10 points or less and this goes for both teams.
- 7. Game time is forfeit time. Forfeits count as a game. Games can start with 4 players. Please have your teams arrive 15-20 minutes early prior to game time as games may start early.
- 8. Will be 2- 16 minute halves with a running clock. Clock will stop for timeouts and free throws only. If the score is 10 points or **LESS** the clock will stop the last 2 minutes of game for dead balls.
- 9. If game is tied at end of regulation, 2 minute overtime will be played. If tied again then play will go to sudden death.
- 10. 5 personal fouls per player. Bonus free throw on 7th team foul. 2 free throws on 10th team foul.
- 11. 3 timeouts per game. 1 for overtime.
- 12. Roster changes must be made before 1st game. Please check with site manager.
- 13. 2 coaches only per team on bench, only Head coach is allowed to stand.
- 14. Players and coaches are responsible for articles and belongings and bring own warm up balls.
- 15. Site managers and game officials have the authority to remove fans, coaches and players that do not show good sportsmanship. Please make it enjoyable for everyone.
- 16. Tie breaker criteria 1-Head to Head 2-Points allowed 3-Point differential
- 17. Tournament management reserves the right to change rules if needed.
